Project description

In the Federal Republic of Germany nationwide road traffic counts are carried out every five years. They are conducted in order to monitor traffic developments and to determine traffic volumes on motorways as well as on federal, state and county roads. The counting results are an essential basis for road and traffic planning.

The road traffic count 2005 was carried out in the area of the offices Aachen and Mönchengladbach of the State Office for Road Construction in North Rhine-Westphalia of 780 counting points and with more than 1300 traffic counters. The counts took place in three periods during the months June until September. The traffic volumes were recorded by separating into eight different vehicle groups. The collected data were subsequently checked for plausibility and edited into the federal standard program for traffic counts. The carrying out of the traffic count included particularly the coordination as well as the personnel and financial administration of the supervision and counting staff.
